

OUT ISLANDS EXPLORATION

Off the Beaten Path

Venture to the remote Out Islands, where rich history, pristine reefs, and secluded beaches promise a one-of-a-kind Bahamian adventure.

Day 1: Crooked Island

Arrive at a private airstrip just a short distance from the marina, where the remote beauty of the Bahamas will immediately captivate you. Upon arrival, you'll be welcomed with a refreshing cocktail prepared by the chief stewardess while the captain briefs you on the exciting adventures ahead. As you explore LUCKY LADY, the chef will be crafting a lunch that promises to be as breathtaking as your surroundings. Once you've settled in, the mate will guide you on your first adventure—exploring an abandoned lighthouse dating back to 1876, a fascinating glimpse into the island's history.

Day 2: Crooked Island to Attwood Harbour (34NM)

In the morning, we'll set sail for a 3-hour journey to the secluded Attwood Harbour. This pristine anchorage is surrounded by powdery white sand beaches, offering the perfect backdrop for snorkeling in vibrant reefs and wandering along endless, untouched shores.

Day 3: Attwood Harbour to Samana Cay (22NM)

After a refreshing morning snorkel, we'll depart on a 2.5-hour voyage to the uninhabited island of Samana. Be sure to take in the sights from the flybridge as we navigate the narrow, aptly named Propeller Cut. Once anchored, you'll have the chance to explore the pristine reefs, where vibrant marine life thrives in crystal-clear waters. Spend the afternoon snorkeling and discovering the underwater beauty of this remote location.

Day 4: Samana Cay

We'll spend another day anchored at Samana to fully enjoy all this remote island has to offer. Start your day with a thrilling bluewater fishing excursion, where you could reel in yellowfin tuna, wahoo, or maybe even a blue marlin. After the excitement of the morning, take a tender ride to the long, winding sandbar. Here, you can stroll along the powdery white sand, searching for rare and beautiful shells, or simply float in the crystal-clear waters, soaking in the serene beauty of this special spot.

Day 5: Samana to San Salvador (75NM)

Before the sun rises, LUCKY LADY will quietly get underway, allowing you to wake up with the gentle rocking of the boat as we head toward San Salvador. After a peaceful 7-hour journey, you'll arrive at this historic island, where adventure awaits. For certified divers, a special treat is in store—a rendezvous dive with a local dive company. San Salvador offers some of the most stunning wall dives in the Bahamas, and you'll have the chance to explore these vibrant underwater cliffs. Keep an eye out for SpongeBob, a friendly local grouper known for his playful interactions with divers. Afterward, you can visit the spot where Columbus first made landfall and snorkel over the very reef where his anchor once rested.

Day 6: San Salvador to Conception Island (37NM)

A 3.5-hour voyage brings you to Conception Island, home to the most pristine and untouched reefs in all of the Bahamas. Once here, you'll find it difficult to ever want to leave this serene paradise.

Day 7: Conception Island

Protected by the Bahamas National Trust, Conception Island is a no-fishing zone, which means its reefs are teeming with life. Spend your morning snorkeling among vibrant coral structures, colorful reef fish, and perhaps even a few sea turtles. In the afternoon, explore Conception Creek, a tranquil waterway that offers sanctuary to sea turtles and a myriad of other marine species.

Day 8: Conception Island to Great Exuma (45NM)

As our journey draws to a close, we'll embark on one last 4-hour cruise from the breathtaking Conception Island to the stunning waters of Great Exuma. Along the way, enjoy a sumptuous brunch that will leave a lasting impression on your palate, ensuring your final moments aboard LUCKY LADY are as unforgettable as the rest of your voyage.
